A \$76 million biosolids (by-product of sewage treatment) facility is being built next to the Black Rock Water Reclamation Plant near Breamlea and will transform a waste product into a nutrient-rich farm fertilizer and renewable fuel.

The Black Rock Water Reclamation plant is also being enhanced to produce up to 5,000 million litres of recycled water a year for residential developments, agriculture and industry.

We have planted our 60,000th tree, edging us closer to our target of 100,000 native trees, shrubs and grasses at the site.
